## Equine Influenza Policy

To protect the health of all equines attending West Somerset & Exmoor Bridleways Association (WS&EBA) events, the following rules will apply from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024:

A valid passport and vaccination record:

- must accompany the horse / pony to all events
- must be available for inspection by the event officials
- must be produced on request at any other time during the event

No equine should attend an event in any way, unless it has a Record of Vaccination against equine influenza completed by the veterinary surgeon who gave the vaccination, signed and stamped line by line, which complies with the Minimum Vaccination Requirements set out in the Equine Influenza Vaccination Schedule below:

Equine Influenza Vaccination Schedule:

**Vaccination 1**

**Vaccination 2**                      **21-60 days after vaccination 1**

**Vaccination 3**                      **120-180 days after vaccination 2**

**Vaccination 4 onwards within 12 months of the previous vaccination**

If you are unsure you can check vaccination intervals using this [Vaccination Calculator](#) from the British Horse Racing Authority (please note that the details under further information on the calculator page relate to horses racing only)

Equines may not take part in an event until at least 7 days have elapsed after vaccination 2 (for clarity: no equine may compete on the same day as a relevant injection is given or on any of the 6 days following such an injection).
